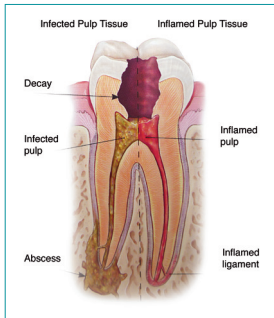

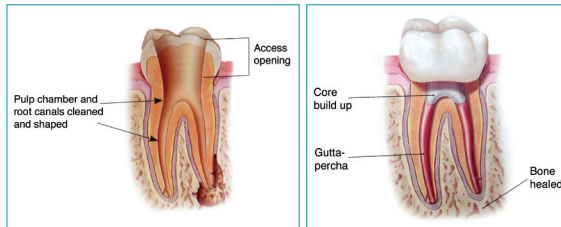
Why would you need endodontic treatment?

Endodontic treatment or root canal treatment is necessary when the inside of the tooth (the pulp) becomes inflamed or infected. The most common reasons for inflammation or infection are deep cavities (caries), repeated dental procedures, cracks or chips. Trauma can also cause inflammation and often shows up as discoloration of the tooth. If pulp inflammation or infection is left untreated, it can cause pain or lead to an abscess.



How can endodontic treatment help you?

The endodontist removes the inflamed or infected pulp, carefully cleans and shapes the canal system and then seals the prepared space. Most treatment is now performed in a single appointment ranging from 45-120 minutes (depending on the number of canals). Once treatment is completed, you will be instructed to return to your dentist for a permanent restoration. The restoration of the tooth is an important part of treatment because it seals the cleaned and filled canals from the oral environment, protects the tooth and restores it to function.



Will you feel pain during or after the procedure?

Toothache is the main reason for patients seeking treatment. Fortunately, modern anaesthetics can make the procedure pain free in most cases. Seeking treatment early makes the procedure more comfortable; **so don't wait**. When caught early, treatment should feel no different than having a regular filling. For the first few days after treatment, there may be some sensitivity to biting pressure, especially if there was pain or infection before the procedure. Sometimes over-the-counter anti-inflammatory medications (like ibuprofen) are recommended for a day or two. Drs. Webber and Lamb can prescribe other medications but they are rarely required.

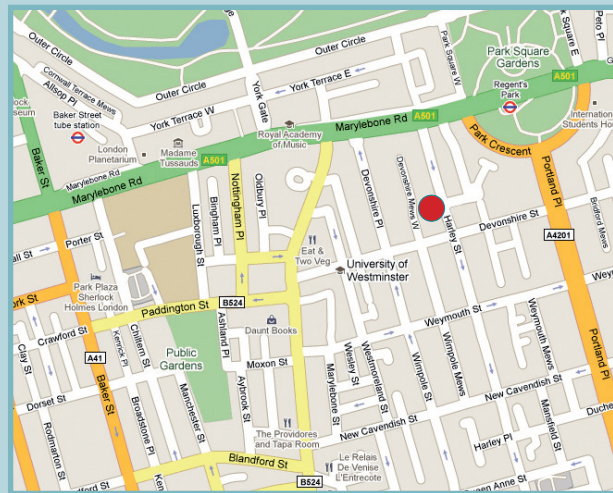

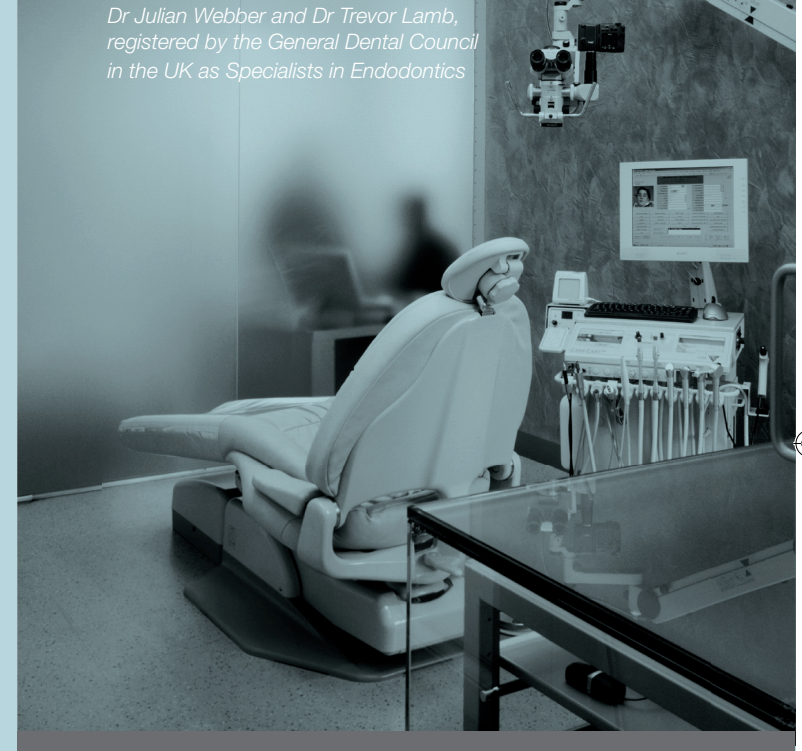
